New Out of Hours - Emergency Repair Number

We have changed the number you need to ring if you require an out-of-hours emergency repair. The number you should now dial is:

053 937 4811

Our out-of-hours phone is switched on Monday to Friday from 5.00pm to 9.00am and all day over weekends and public holidays. This number is for emergency repair calls only; including but not limited to fire, flood, or emergency repairs to heating and hot water systems. In the case of a gas leak, break in or fire you should contact the relevant emergency services numbers first. Utilities firms should be contacted when mains supplies of electricity, gas or water are affected. If you wish to call out of hours and leave a message regarding any other matter please call the main line number 01 820 0002 and your message will be passed on to your Housing Officer the next working day.

Please also note that from the 1st of July the main line (01 820 0002) will not be answered between 1pm and 2pm, Monday to Friday. If you call during this time, please leave a message and your call will be returned by the appropriate person. **Do not use the out of hours number during this time.**




McArdle Green, Moneymore

We produce a number of different communications to you each year. We do this as it is important to us that we keep you informed about current and relevant community issues and also information on your tenancy with North and East.

We want to make sure that the information we provide is actually useful and interesting so we would love to hear your feedback. We are looking for volunteers to be part of our new Resident Reading Panel where you will be able to tell us what is important to you.

This would involve panel reviewing communications before we send them out so that we can capture your opinions. This is done in the comfort of your own home and would mean taking an hour out of your day approximately four times a year. We would send you the documents by email or post and provide convenient ways to get the information back. By volunteering to be part of the panel it allows you the opportunity to influence what information we sent out and even how we send it out. Eircode is launching in 2015

Over the next few months you should receive a letter notifying you of your Eircode for your home. An Eircode is unique to your house, so if you move home, you don't have to take Eircode with you.

Eircodes will be similar to the postcodes currently used in the UK. The implementation of Eircode will be very simple, and it will not affect your current postal service.

You do not need to change your address, an Eircode is simply added to the end of your address. For the moment, you don't need to do anything. You will be sent a letter in summer 2015 informing you of the Eircode for your address and how to use it.


